The Holy Spirit and Witnessing

Matthew 4:1 (NKJV) *Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit...*

Acts 2:38 (NKJV) *Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.*

Luke 24:48-49 *You are witnesses of these things. And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.”*

Hebrews 2:3–4 (NKJV) *how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him, ⁴ God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?*

Acts 1:8 (NKJV) *But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”*

The Holy Spirit, the Word, and Witnessing

John 14:26 (NKJV) *But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.*

Acts 8:26–33 (NKJV) Now **an angel of the Lord** spoke to Philip, saying, “Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza.” This is desert. ²⁷ So he arose and went. And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, ²⁸ was returning. And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet. ²⁹ **Then the Spirit** said to Philip, “Go near and overtake this chariot.” ³⁰ So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah, and said, “Do you understand what you are reading?” ³¹ And he said, “How can I, unless someone guides me?” And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him. ³² The place in the Scripture which he read was this: “He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; And as a lamb before its shearer is silent, So He opened not His mouth. ³³ In His humiliation His justice was taken away, And who will declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth.”

John 6:63 *It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.*

John 16:13 *“However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.*

The Holy Spirit is often the “still small voice” we hear.

Revelation 2:7 *He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches;*

Weather reading the Bible or listening to a sermon the Holy Spirit gives life to the word, and us ears to hear.

The Life-Transforming Power of the Holy Spirit

Ezekiel 36:27 *“I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.*

Someone once said the Holy Spirit helps us to UNDERSTAND the truth with our heads, BELIEVE it in our hearts, then LIVE it with our hands FOLLOW it with our feet. Or you might say, wisdom, then worship, works, then walk.

Romans 8:13, 14 *For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.*

Acts 5:32 *“And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.”*

The Lord opened her heart to heed the things spoken by Paul. ¹⁵ And when she and her household were baptized, she begged us, saying, “If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay.” So she persuaded us.*

2 Corinthians 5:17 *Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.*

Galatians 5:22–23 *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace,*

Romans 5:5 *... because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.*

John 14:27 (NKJV) *Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. **Depressed witness.***

Acts 9:31 *Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.*

Romans 14:17 (NKJV) ⁷ *for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.*
