## Preparation For The End Time Lesson #4 Salvation and the End Time

### Memory Verse Get Scriptures to read

**1 John 4:10** (NKJV) In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

One fascinating but crucial difference between Christianity and non-Christian religions is that while the others emphasize what their founders have taught them, they do not emphasize what their founders have done for them. And that's because whatever their founders may have done for them, it cannot save them. All these leaders can do is try to teach the people how to "save" themselves.

#### The Love of the Father

John 14:8–11 (NKJV) Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves. People say that the God of the Old Testament is a God of justice in comparison to the God of the New Testament, who is full of mercy?

**John 16:27** (NKJV) for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God.

**John 3:16** (NKJV) For God [The Father] so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

**1 John 4:8** He who does not love does not know God, for God is love. **Psalm 143:8** (NKJV) Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, For in You do I trust; Cause me to know the way in which I should walk, For I lift up my soul to You.

**Psalm 145:8** (NKJV) The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy.

\*Psalm 147:11 (NKJV) The Lord takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy.

**Jeremiah 29:11** For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

**Zephaniah 3:17** (NKJV) The Lord your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

**Malachi 3:6** (NKJV) "For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.

### The Love of Christ

John 1:1–5 (NKJV) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. <sup>4</sup> In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Philippians 2:5–8 (NKJV) <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

"The earth was dark through misapprehension of God. That the gloomy shadows might be lightened, that the world might be brought back to God, Satan's deceptive power was to be broken."—DA, p. 22.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, Hebrews 1:3 (NKJV) who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high,

This was the same One who was found as a "babe lying in a manger" (Luke 2:16). This means that the One who "is before all things, and in Him all things consist" (Col. 1:17, NKJV) is the same One who, as a human child, "increased in wisdom and stature" (Luke 2:52). This means that the One without whom "nothing was made that was made" (John 1:3, NKJV) was the same One who was "murdered by hanging on a tree" (Acts 5:30, NKJV).

# The Love of the Spirit

\*Romans 5:5 (NKJV) Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

Galatians 5:22, "The fruit of the Holy Spirit is love."

**Colossians 1:8** (NKJV) who also declared to us your love in the Spirit.

**Romans 15:30** (NKJV) Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the love of the Spirit, that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me,

**Luke 12:12** (NKJV) For the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say."

**John 14:26** (*NKJV*) But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

**John 16:4** (NKJV) But these things I have told you, that when the time comes, you may remember that I told you of them. "And these things I did not say to you at the beginning, because I was with you.

**John 14:27** (NKJV) Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

**Acts 13:2** (NKJV) As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

**Romans 8:26** (NKJV) Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

### **Assurance of Salvation**

**Psalm 91:15–16** (NKJV) He shall call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him and honor him. <sup>16</sup> With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation."

**Joel 2:31–32** The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the moon into blood, Before the coming of the great and awesome day of the Lord. <sup>32</sup>And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the Lord has said, Among the remnant whom the Lord calls.

\*John 6:37 (NKJV) All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.

**John 10:28** (NKJV) And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

**Romans 10:9–11** (NKJV) that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. <sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."

### Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector

Luke 18:9–14 (NKJV) Also He spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: <sup>10</sup> "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. <sup>11</sup> The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank You that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. <sup>12</sup> I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess.' <sup>13</sup> And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise his eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!' <sup>14</sup> I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

## The Everlasting Gospel

**Revelation 14:6–7** (NKJV) Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people—<sup>7</sup> saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."

Micah 5:2 (NKJV) "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, Though you are little among the thousands of Judah, Yet out of you shall come forth to Me The One to be Ruler in Israel, Whose goings forth are from of old, From everlasting."

**Ephesians 1:4** (NKJV) just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

**Revelation 13:8** (NKJV) All who dwell on the earth will worship him, whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

**Revelation 17:8** (NKJV) And those who dwell on the earth will marvel, whose names are not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.
