Rev 17:1-6 Read a little review.

Thaumazo - (Thavmazo) [Gr] **To wonder; to admire: marvel.**

1 Pet 5:13 *She who is in Babylon, elect together with you, greets you;*

Eph 5:25 *Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, [Whore. pornē, "prostitute,"]*

Hosea 1:2 *When the LORD began to speak by Hosea, the LORD said to Hosea: "Go, take yourself a wife of harlotry And children of harlotry, For the land has committed great harlotry By departing from the LORD." Harlot is used ... 43 times in Ezekiel*

Seven Heads and Ten Horns (2 Slides) (Sounds Familiar)

Rev 12:3 *And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having **seven heads and ten horns**, and seven diadems on his heads.*

Rev 13:1 *Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having **seven heads and ten horns**, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name.*

Seven Hills?

Rev 17:9 *"Here is the mind which has wisdom: The seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits. Rome, the capital city of Italy, has historically been known as the 'City of Seven Hills.'*

Who is This Woman?

Revelation 17:18 *"And the woman whom you saw is that great city which reigns over the kings of the earth." Pagan Powers*

Scarlet and Purple (2 Slides)

Scarlet and purple are the official colors of the hierarchy of the Roman Catholic Church. **Cardinals wear Scarlet robes** and **Archbishops wear Purple robes** at official church functions.

Gold and Precious Stones and Pearls

The gold, pearls and precious stones with which she is decked can be plainly seen at a typical event held at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The altar is decked with these ornaments. ***Read Catholic Teachings!**

A Golden Cup (2 Slides)

Seen in the hand of the Pope each time he conducts the Mass.

Jer 51:6-9 *Flee from the midst of Babylon, And every one save his life! Do not be cut off in her iniquity, For this is the time of the Lord's vengeance; He shall recompense her. Babylon was **a golden cup** in the Lord's hand, That made all the earth drunk. The nations drank her wine; Therefore the nations are deranged. Babylon has suddenly fallen and been destroyed. Wail for her! Take balm for her pain; Perhaps she may be healed. We would have healed Babylon, But she is not healed. Forsake her, and let us go everyone to his own country; For her judgment reaches to heaven and is lifted up to the skies.*

Names of Blasphemy

On April 30, 1922 Pope Pius XI said;

"You know that I am the Holy Father, the representative of God on the earth, the Vicar of Christ, which means I am God on the earth."

Independent Country

The Vatican is the world's smallest country. In 1929, under the terms of the Lateran Treaty, Vatican City was established as an independent state of 109 acres within Rome. 1000 population. **Beginning January 1st 2009**, the Pope declared that the Vatican will no longer automatically adopt Italian laws.

Heaven Rejoices Over Babylon End

Rev 19:1-3 *After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! "For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her." Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!"*

Marriage Supper of the Lamb

Rev 19:8, 9 *And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' " And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."*

Mat 22:2 *"The kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who arranged a marriage for his son,*

Mat 22:7, 8 *"But when the king heard about it, he was furious. And he sent out his armies, destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city. "Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy.*

King to the Rescue

Rev 19:11-13 *Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.*

Feast of the Vultures

Rev 19:17, 18 *Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, "that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great."*

Lake of Fire

Rev 19:19, 20 *And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.*
