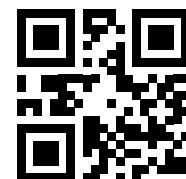

Word Heart

Memorize:

Come near to Me, hear this: I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, I was there. And now the Lord GOD and His Spirit have sent Me (Isaiah 48:16).

Some say that the concept of the triune Godhead—one God in three Persons—is a New Testament church invention. While in Pastor Doug’s feature article this month, he focuses on the Holy Spirit’s role in this divine mystery, mostly as it is revealed in the New Testament, you can actually find many wonderful “hints” of the Godhead in the Old Testament as well.

Genesis 1:26 is, perhaps, the most obvious example. Here, God refers to Himself in plural terms: “Let Us make man in Our image.” This phrasing points to the multiplicity of God while still affirming His singular nature. This is not a case of Moses’ accidental miswording, as Isaiah later affirms, “I heard the voice of the LORD, saying: ‘Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?’” (6:8). Again, the language invites us to contemplate God’s plurality—opening the door to a distinct Father, a distinct Son, and a distinct Holy Spirit, all working together in one and as one.



That leads us to our memory verse, where the speaker refers to “the Lord God,” “His Spirit,” and “Me.” Many scholars interpret this as a reference to the Father (the Lord God), the Holy Spirit (His Spirit), and the Son (the one speaking—understood to be the pre-incarnate Christ). The speaker identifies Himself as eternal, present “from the beginning,” and then makes it clear that He is sent by both the Father and the Spirit. This foreshadows the New Testament claim that Christ is the One sent by the Father, empowered by the Holy Spirit. (And let’s not forget Isaiah 9:6, which prophesies Jesus being called “Mighty God.”)


The presence of the Godhead in the Old Testament invites us to reflect deeply on the nature of God, and that’s exactly what Pastor Doug invites you to do in this issue of the *Inside Report*. God’s eternal unity reveals a Being who sees tremendous value in fellowship, relationship, and love—and a God who works to redeem humanity through the harmonious, self-sacrificial actions of His three distinct personalities.

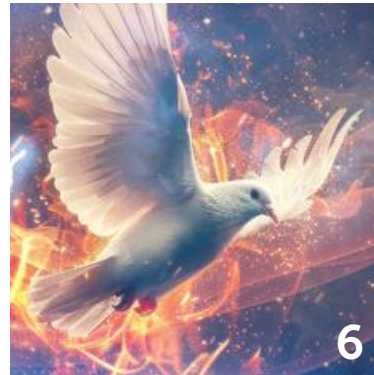

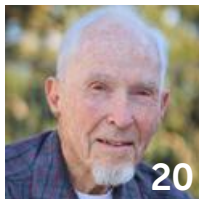

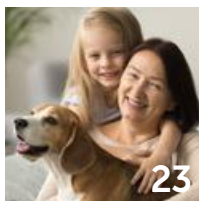

The HOLY SPIRIT

Exploring the Divine Mystery

An Amazing Fact:

Every minute of every day, the earth is struck by approximately 6,000 lightning strikes. The average lightning bolt travels about 30,000 times faster than a bullet and can reach 50,000 degrees Fahrenheit—hotter than the surface of the sun! However, it is a myth that lightning never strikes twice in the same place. For instance, the top of the Empire State Building averages over 20 hits per year. In like manner, the Bible predicts the Holy Spirit will come upon the church again in the last days with the same light and power as in the days of Pentecost.

Whenever I teach on the doctrine of the Holy Spirit, I can get a little overwhelmed because the topic is so big. It's infinite in scope! At the same time, I'm saddened and even burdened by the fact that so many churchgoing Christians are confused about the nature and role of this absolutely real—but admittedly mysterious—person of the eternal Godhead.

To put it mildly, the Holy Spirit is under attack by self-identifying Christians like never before, and I don't think this phenomenon is a mere coincidence considering our place in end-time events. In these last days, we're going to need God's Spirit to energize us like a lightning bolt from heaven, so it's not surprising that the devil has chosen to

sow confusion among the church about this subject. It's important for us to take the time to dive into the Word of God and get to know the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit: A Who or a What?

Some teach that the Holy Spirit is a mere influence or force that comes from God, but Scripture portrays Him as having a distinct personality within the Godhead. I admit, sometimes in a sermon, you might even catch me sounding as though I'm speaking of the Holy Spirit like He's some mystical energy floating in the air. But the Bible is clear that the Holy Spirit is a real being—a vital one, too, because He's found throughout the entire book.

In fact, you'll find Him more than 500 times in Scripture. He's mentioned in just the second verse of the Bible: "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ... And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters" (Genesis 1:1, 2). You also find Him in the last chapter of the Bible: "And the Spirit and the bride say, 'Come!'" (Revelation 22:17).

The Spirit is also not, as one might say, an "it" or a "thing"—He is a "He," a being with His own identity, personality, and purpose. The Bible provides many clues to this unique personhood:

- **Ephesians 4:30:** "Do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption." The Holy Spirit feels sorrow when believers act in ways contrary to God's will. Can an unthinking force feel anything?
- **Romans 15:30:** "I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the love of the Spirit, that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me." The apostle Paul indicates here that the Holy Spirit possesses and expresses love—something an unthinking force cannot do.
- **1 Corinthians 12:11:** "But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills." The Holy Spirit has a unique will and makes decisions, revealing to us that He possesses His own agency. Of course, His agency aligns with the Father and Son!



Furthermore, in John 14:16, 17, Jesus calls the Holy Spirit "another Helper." The word for "Helper" in the original Greek is *parakletos*, which means "one called alongside to help." Jesus said that the Holy Spirit would "teach you all things" and "bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you" (John 14:26). Teaching and reminding imply an active intelligence.

The Holy Spirit and the Godhead

In Acts 5, Peter confronts Ananias for lying about the earnings received for selling property:

Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the **Holy Spirit** and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? ... Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not lied to men but to **God** (vv. 3, 4, my emphasis).

Do you see that Peter initially accuses Ananias of lying to the Holy Spirit? But then, in verse 4, Peter clarifies that by lying to the Holy Spirit, Ananias has lied to God. This shows that the early church considered lying to the Holy Spirit equivalent to lying to God the Father.



Does this mean there is more than one God? After all, Scripture says,

Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one!
You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength
(Deuteronomy 6:4, 5).

Yes, Christians worship one God! Yet, before Deuteronomy, Genesis 1:26 says, "God said, 'Let **Us** make

man in **Our** image'" (my emphasis). But how can you have one God in plural form?

Well, in Genesis 2:24, a man and a woman are said to cleave to one another in marriage and become one. Why one? It doesn't mean they are sharing DNA; it means they are united in their purpose for life.

Interestingly, Jesus once prayed that the 12 apostles be "one" in the same way the three persons of the Godhead are one: "that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me" (John 17:21).

So when the Bible says there is one God, it's not speaking of numerical quantity. Rather, it speaks to God's unity. Many pagan religions have different gods, but for Christians, there is just one God, with three perfect personalities and unique roles, perfectly united in one—and all three are cooperating for our salvation. Consider further these telling passages:

1 John 5:7: "For there are three that bear witness in heaven: the Father, the Word [Jesus], and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one."

When Jesus said, "I and My Father are one," religious leaders took up stones to kill Him for blasphemy, "Because You [Jesus], being a Man, make Yourself God" (John 10:30, 33). Here, John calls the Holy Spirit one with God and Christ, meaning the apostle believed that the Holy Spirit is God.



Notice here that just after Christ was baptized, the Spirit of God descended and a voice from heaven sounded. That's the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit acting independently of one another in one place and time but for the same purpose!

Jesus also believed the Holy Spirit was God because He lumps in the Holy Spirit with Himself and with God the Father: "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Matthew 28:19).

What Does the Holy Spirit Do?

When Jesus walked the earth, He left footprints. The Holy Spirit doesn't leave footprints.

That's why when Jesus spoke about the Holy Spirit, He compared Him to the wind: "The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit" (John 3:8).

Do you believe there is wind? Even though you can't see it, you can see its effect in the trees and feel it on your being. Can we see the Holy Spirit? No. Sometimes God does allow the Holy Spirit to appear in different forms to help us to understand Him better. When Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit took on the form of a dove. On the Day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit appeared as tongues of fire. Is the Holy Spirit a tongue of fire or a wind? No. In these cases, the form the Holy Spirit took was a metaphor for His work in our lives.

Whereas God the Son took on the form of a human and was restricted geographically to one place at a time, the amazing thing about the Holy Spirit is that He can be everywhere at one time. This is one reason why Jesus said, "It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper [Holy Spirit] will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you" (John 16:7).

But you might now be wondering, what exactly does the Holy Spirit do?

1 He Helps Us Understand God's Word. One of the primary roles of the Holy Spirit is to open our minds to understanding the Scripture—the most vital work in these last days. In fact, you cannot understand anything spiritual without the Holy Spirit! He is the One who takes the words of God and makes them spring up in our hearts.

John 6:63: "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."

John 14:26: "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you."



In 1 Corinthians 2:10, Paul further explains, "God has revealed [truths] to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God." Without

the Holy Spirit, spiritual truths remain hidden. But with Him, the Bible becomes a living guide, providing direction, wisdom, and encouragement.

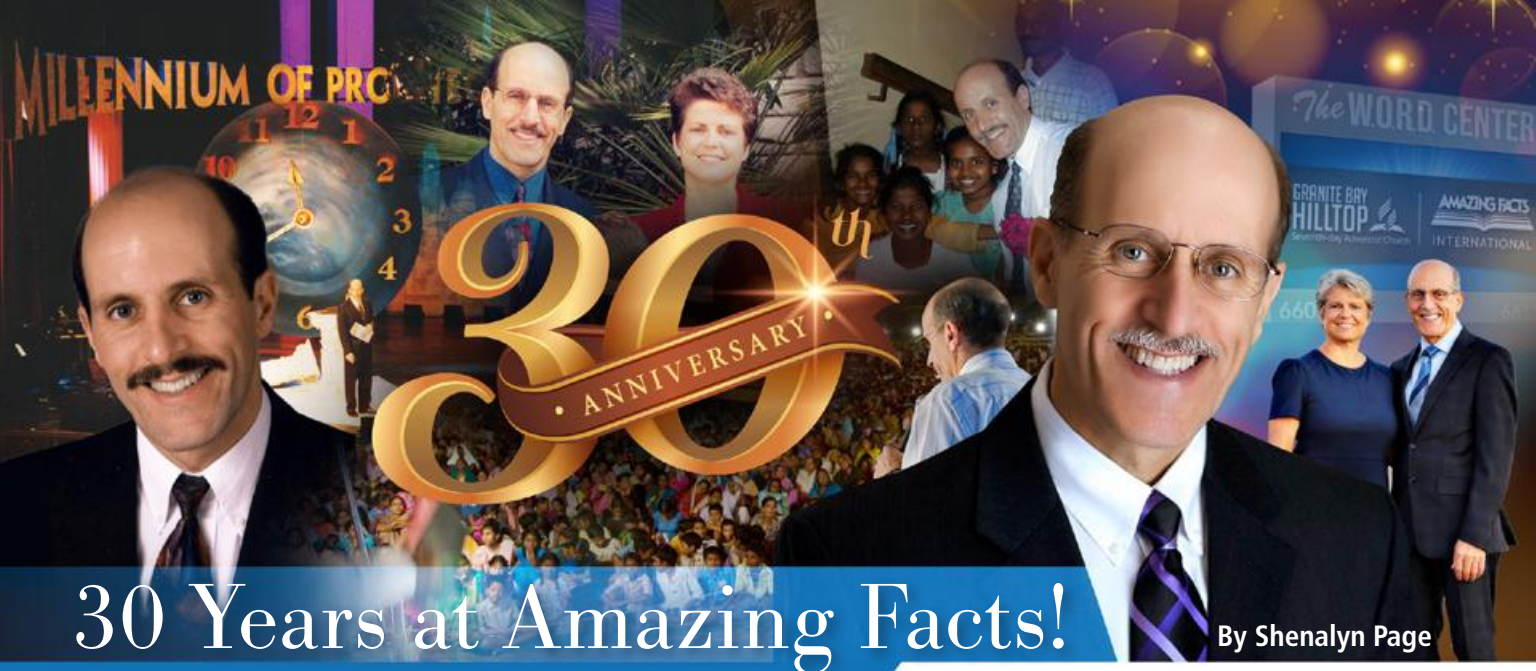
2 He Helps Us Pray. Many times, we may struggle with what to pray or even how to express our deepest concerns to God. Romans 8:26 says, "The Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered." Do you see that? The Holy Spirit translates our emotions into prayers that align with God's will, interceding on our behalf! Even when we can't find the words, the Spirit is there praying through us and presenting our needs to the Father.

3 He Helps Us Obey. Obedience to God's commands is only possible through the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus told His disciples, "If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper" (John 14:15, 16). This Helper is the Holy Spirit, who empowers us to follow God's laws, including honoring His true Sabbath day when doing so isn't popular, and live according to His will.

The apostle Paul also emphasizes in Romans 8:13, "For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live." The Spirit enables us to overcome our sinful tendencies and to walk in the newness of His life. Without Him, we would be unable to resist temptation or make lasting changes. With Him, we find the strength to live in a way that genuinely honors God.

4 He Provides Comfort and Peace. The Holy Spirit is called the Comforter, a title Jesus ascribed to Him in John 14:16–18 when He

In 1994, Doug Batchelor took the reins at Amazing Facts—and for the past three decades, God has blessed his down-to-earth leadership and bold preaching. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the ministry has grown exponentially and tens of thousands have been baptized.

Says Pastor Doug, "Over these past 30 years, I've seen God expand this ministry's outreach in such amazing ways. It boggles my mind! A 30-Year Adventure

Pastor Doug hadn't planned to lead an international ministry. In fact, in 1993, he and his wife, Karen, turned down an invitation to join Amazing Facts. However, they did agree to pray about the call. Says Karen, "We were so inspired by Joe Crews," the ministry's first speaker. "We didn't feel capable of following in his footsteps."

However, in 1994, at the urging of Pastor Crews, the Amazing Facts board reached out again and the Batchelors accepted. Not long after, the ministry moved to California. Ever since, the ministry has grown from broadcasting on just a few TV stations to over 100 in the USA. And worldwide broadcasts now reach two billion lives.

Along with his many regular speaking engagements, Pastor Doug has preached at least one major evangelistic series every year. He also led the development of the W.O.R.D. Center, the ministry's headquarters, which was

completed debt-free in 2021. The church, for which Pastor Doug serves as senior pastor, partners with Amazing Facts in local outreach and hosts regular summits on biblical topics.

Worldwide Impact

The Batchelors have traveled extensively to spread the gospel since joining Amazing Facts. "I've preached in more than 60 countries since I've been here," says Pastor Doug.

"It's a wonderful thing to see people's lives changed through the gospel."

Adds Karen, "We've been blessed to travel to so many places and meet so many wonderful people. Our trip to Papua New Guinea years ago was especially memorable. About 80,000 people gathered to hear God's Word. It was amazing to see their hunger for truth."

Bible Answers

with Pastor Doug Batchelor



What does it mean that Christ preached to “spirits” who were in prison?



This question comes from 1 Peter 3:18–20:

Christ also suffered once for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive by the Spirit, by whom also He went and preached to the spirits in prison, who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.


This passage has certainly confused many Bible students! Some popular teachers say it means Christ literally descended into the depths of the earth and preached to lost souls living in some form of limbo. But this is far from the text’s actual message—and it gives a dangerous and faulty impression that a person can somehow be saved after having died lost.

First, notice how Christ preached to those spirits. He did it “by the Spirit,” referring to the Holy Spirit. So whatever Christ did in preaching at this time, He did it through the Holy Spirit. When was the preaching done? “When once the Divine

longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared.” The preaching was done while the ark was being built—when Noah warned the world before God sent the Flood.

It also tells us when. While the ark was being prepared, God was longsuffering. Peter is almost certainly referring to the passage in Genesis 6:3, which explains the who, what, and when: “The LORD said, ‘My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.’”

Finally, to whom was the preaching done? “To the spirits in prison.” Throughout the Bible, we find this terminology used to describe those who are bound in the prison house of sin. David prayed, “Bring my soul out of prison” (Psalm 142:7). The mission of Jesus was “to proclaim liberty to the captives” (Isaiah 61:1). Thus, Peter here is telling us that it was the Spirit of Christ who preached through Noah in the days before the Flood. Jesus was there, through the Holy Spirit, to speak conviction to hearts and appeal to the lost to come into the ark.

The question for you, friend, is this: “Are you a captive in Satan’s prison of sin?” Jesus, through the call of the Holy Spirit to your heart, is inviting you to receive salvation so that you can be set free!

promised His disciples that they would not be left “orphans” (KJV). This role is crucial, as the Holy Spirit brings peace that transcends circumstances. When we face trials, we can rely on Him to provide inner calm and assurance. As Paul writes in Romans 14:17, “For the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.”

The Spirit’s comfort goes beyond simple reassurance; it anchors us in God’s love and gives us confidence that we are not alone. His presence reassures us, reminding us that God’s promises are sure and that we have access to a supernatural peace that “surpasses all understanding” (Philippians 4:7).

“How Can I Have the Holy Spirit?”

So, we’ve established that the Holy Spirit is God, that He is a person, and that He has a vital work in these last days. As we close out, you might be wondering how you can invite this amazing Spirit into your life.

1

Ask and Seek Earnestly. Jesus encourages us to ask for the Holy Spirit: “If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your

heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!” (Luke 11:13). God is willing to fill us with His Spirit, but He waits for us to actively seek Him. This is more than a one-time request; it’s a continual pursuit of God’s presence in our lives.

2

Be Born of the Spirit. Jesus made it clear in John 3:5 that “unless one is born of water and the Spirit,

he cannot enter the kingdom of God.” This rebirth signifies a transformation that only the Holy Spirit can bring, turning us from old ways and setting us on a new path. Baptism represents the cleansing of our sins, but the filling of the Spirit signifies empowerment for a life of holiness.

3

Yield to God’s Will. The Holy Spirit fills those who are willing to surrender their own desires for God’s purposes. Romans 12:1 encourages believers to “present your bodies a living sacrifice” to God, allowing the Holy Spirit to take control. A life filled with the Spirit is marked by humility, obedience, and a readiness to follow wherever God leads.


4

Abide in Jesus Daily. To be filled with the Spirit, we must remain connected to Jesus. In John 15:5, Jesus teaches, “He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.” This daily abiding involves spending time in prayer, meditating on Scripture, and seeking God’s guidance. The Holy Spirit flows in the lives of those who stay close to Christ.

The Holy Spirit is essential for every believer. He opens our understanding of God’s Word, intercedes in our prayers, empowers us for obedience, and brings peace and comfort in every circumstance. Perhaps members of your church are trying to convince you otherwise, but the

Bible makes it clear that Jesus left us with a Helper, the Spirit of truth, to guide us through life and to prepare us for His return. Don’t let anyone take that promise from you!

And if you haven’t experienced the fullness of the Holy Spirit in your life, Jesus invites you to ask. In John 7:37, 38, He said, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink ... out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”

Would you like to receive the Holy Spirit today? As we open our hearts to His presence in these final days, He fills us with the strength, wisdom, and peace needed to walk faithfully with God, come what may. I encourage you to invite the Spirit into your life daily, allowing His power to transform you and to shine as a light in a world that desperately needs His truth.

PROPHECY ODYSSEY

Reaching New York and the World

This past fall, through the support of compassionate ministry friends like you, Amazing Facts broadcast the *Prophecy Odyssey* evangelistic series live from New York City. The 15-part Bible study, presented by Doug Batchelor, president, was hosted at the Manhattan Center from September 20 to October 5 and has reached hundreds of thousands of people globally.

It was one of the biggest outreach efforts—both financially and logistically—in Amazing Facts’ 60-year history.

Prophecy Odyssey was broadcast in English and Spanish on 3ABN, Hope Channel, and AFTV. Also, for the first time, the series was translated into 17 languages live using advanced artificial intelligence, making it accessible to the diverse global audiences tuning in online.

The series brought over 800 attendees nightly at the Manhattan Center, with numbers rising to 1,400 on weekends. Locally, 377 people chose to join the last-day church by baptism or profession of faith. Two new churches were also planted—one Spanish congregation in Manhattan and a Chinese congregation in Brooklyn.

Genesis of *Prophecy Odyssey*

Known for its influence on world affairs and its diverse population, New York City was an easy choice for sharing the gospel as far and wide as possible in a single outreach campaign. Pastor Doug was delighted to return, having been born there and previously leading major evangelistic and revival efforts there, including the 1999 *Millennium of Prophecy* series.

Planning for the event was a challenge, as the logistical and financial demands of hosting a major evangelistic series in New York are steep. Relying on faith and prayer, Amazing Facts forged ahead, believing that God would make a way. As Pastor Doug shared, “We moved forward by faith, and

the Lord opened the door for us to return to the Manhattan Center’s largest venue and present the three angels’ messages in a way we couldn’t have imagined just a few years ago.”

More than 100 Manhattan Missionaries from around the world joined forces with 26 students from the Amazing Facts Center of Evangelism (AFCOE) to spread the message on the ground throughout New York City. They held prayer sessions, distributed literature, and invited locals to the meetings, often encountering spiritual hunger in surprising places. Carlos Muñoz, AFCOE’s director, noted, “We were surprised by the immense spiritual hunger we found all over the city. So many people were receptive to the Spirit’s work through our students and volunteers.”

Many Lives Changed Forever

Testimonies of transformed lives emerged soon as attendees responded to the messages. Patricia, who had struggled with alcohol and identity issues from a young age, found hope and healing through the meetings. Watching Amazing Facts videos had inspired her for years, but the opportunity to attend *Prophecy Odyssey* in person solidified her decision to be baptized. “I’m better than dry,” Patricia declared. “I’m seeking God, and He goes out of His way to show me that He loves me.”

James, hired as a security guard for the event, found himself drawn to the messages while working. Troubled by a smoking addiction, he requested prayer for deliverance, and within days, his desire for tobacco disappeared. “I was so blessed to be paid to listen to these meetings,” James later shared, grateful for his newfound spiritual growth.

The missionaries also held worship services and distributed flyers in Times Square, drawing attention in one of the world’s busiest pedestrian hubs. Among those moved by this outreach was a man named Darian, who stopped to listen only out of curiosity. However, he quickly formed a bond with the missionaries, joining them for the nightly

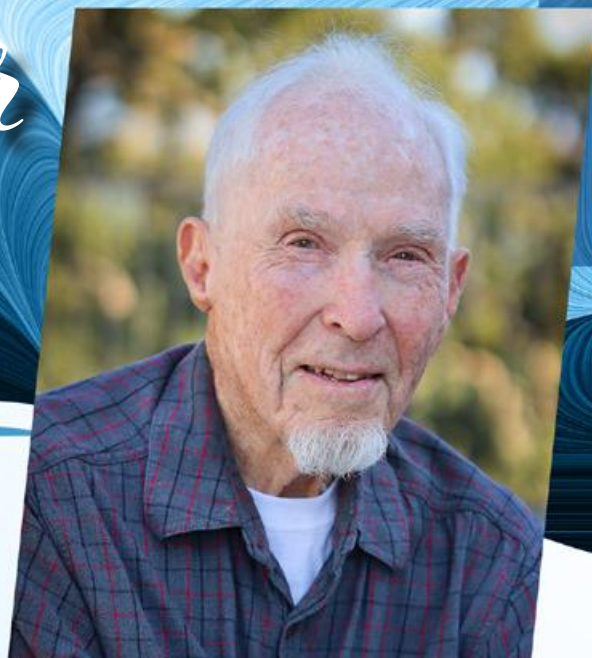

Clyde may be Amazing Facts' oldest volunteer, but you wouldn't know it except for his snow-white goatee. His blue eyes sparkle and hint at stories that could keep you entertained for hours. He shakes your hand like someone much younger than 95.

"I don't feel very useful at my age," he says.

He's not telling you the whole story. He has been retired for more years than he worked for the U.S. Postal Service, but he has been far from idle. He and his beloved wife, Gloria, turned their country acreage into a beautiful haven they affectionately called "Almost Heaven." They also traveled extensively, volunteering to help remodel churches and schools.

When Gloria had a stroke several years ago, the couple moved into a small home near their daughter and son-in-law. He grieved deeply when Gloria passed away, but it didn't take too long for him to find new ways to be useful. He volunteers with a church outreach to homeless people, and he corrects lessons from inmates taking the Amazing Facts Bible Correspondence course.

"I don't do that much really," he says. "I just correct the errors in the Bible lessons, and I pray, 'Lord, benefit this person by this program.' I really need to learn how to pray better."

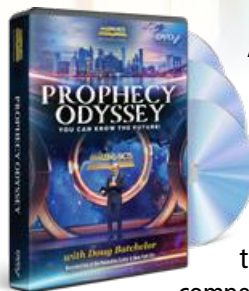

Oil in Your Lamp!

A long time ago, before smartphones and GPS—and even before electricity—large ships were busy bringing supplies into ocean harbors. But that was often a dangerous task, especially during bad weather or at night when the captain couldn't see clearly to safely steer the ship. If the ship missed the turning point, it might run aground on the shore and be damaged. Or it might hit a reef beneath the surface of the water. If that happened, the ship could sink!

To make things safer for ships, people began building lighthouses near the shore. The bright beam from the lighthouse cut through the darkness to help sea captains steer their ships safely in the right direction and avoid accidents.

Many early lighthouses used oil lamps to light the way for ships. The Amelia Island Lighthouse in northern Florida, for example, used 14 oil lamps with reflectors to create a bright, shimmering light to guide seafaring vessels. As long as there was oil in the lamps, the ships were safe.

Have you ever sung the song "Give Me Oil in My Lamp"? It's a great song that's fun to sing, but what does it mean? What does "oil" mean in the song?

Oil is one of the symbols the Bible uses to represent the Holy Spirit. Like the light in a lighthouse that guides a ship, the Holy Spirit guides us and shows us the way to God. And the Holy Spirit is God.

Our God is a Trinity; that means there are three Persons that together are God—God the Father, God the Son (that's Jesus), and God the Holy Spirit. If that seems confusing, you're not alone. This truth is even hard for grown-ups to grasp!

Before Jesus went back to heaven, He promised to send His followers "another Helper"—the Oil we need for our lamps—the Holy Spirit (John 14:16). The Holy Spirit comforts us when we're sad and teaches us to be more like Jesus. He also helps us pray, helps us know when we've done something wrong, and gives us the strength to do what is right. Because of this special Helper, Jesus can be with us all the time, so we'll never be alone!

The Bible talks about the fruits of the Spirit too. These are the good things we will have in our life when we let Jesus live in our heart. Find and circle the different fruits of the Spirit hidden in the puzzle below.

In autumn 2024, Gita's 84-year-old owner fell in his yard, injuring himself. Unable to move, the man eventually asked the 13-year-old, mixed-breed dog to go for help. Springing into action, Gita ran to the nearby road, waited, barked when a deputy sheriff came by, and eventually led the officer to her injured owner, saving his life.¹

And in 2021, a black cat named Piran was credited with saving an 83-year-old woman who had fallen 70 feet into a ravine. Meowing until it attracted the attention of searchers, the faithful feline led rescuers straight to his owner.²

We've all heard stories of exceptional pets like these and admired their heroic actions. But even if our own pets haven't made the headlines or been featured in a viral video, maybe, just maybe, they're our heroes in other ways.

Most of us have experienced, at one time or another, being greeted with unconditional love from a dog or cat. It's often uncanny the way they seem to sense our moods and try to connect with us and lift our spirits. That can sometimes be a turning point that brightens a challenging day. Indeed, simply interacting with a dog or cat can boost the feel-good neurotransmitters dopamine and serotonin, leaving us happier and more relaxed.

But animals can do more than just elevate our mood. Here are additional ways they can boost our health:

1. Pets can improve heart health by lowering blood pressure and blood lipids.³
2. By caring for our furry friends, we get more exercise.
3. Animal antics bring more healthy laughter into our lives.
4. Interacting with a pet can lower the stress hormone cortisol.⁴
5. Those with pets tend to cope better with pain.⁵
6. Owning a pet can improve cognitive function and mental health.⁶
7. Pets can help dispel loneliness in two ways—through their own affectionate interactions with us and by helping us connect with other people.



If you don't already have a furry sidekick and are inspired to try pet ownership, there are a few things to consider when choosing—for instance, your age and agility, allergies, the size of your home and yard, your work schedule, and how often you travel. Are you physically able to walk a dog, or do you have a fenced-in yard—or might an indoor cat better suit your lifestyle and abilities? Do you have friends or family willing to care for your pet when you're away?



Mammals were made on the sixth day of Creation, the same day as humans (Genesis 1:24–28). God has blessed us with a vast assortment of incredible, beautifully designed creatures that share our planet. Many are highly intelligent, emotionally complex life forms that make fantastic companions.

Allowing a pet to share your life, accepting and returning their affection, can improve your health in countless ways and enrich both their existence and yours. And that's something to be grateful for! 📖
