hen I walked into an Amazing Facts prophecy seminar more than a decade ago, I wasn't feeling at all sociable. I didn't speak to anyone. I walked quickly down the aisle and took a seat near an exit. I didn't look at anyone in the eye.

I was there only as a favor to my "strange" Christian brother, who had invited me to come. I was just being nice.

Then something *really* bad happened—someone started singing "Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus." Good grief! I remember rolling my eyes. The sound of the hymn struck me as old fashioned, overwrought, and boring, especially as I was just listening to the

latest top-40 hits on the car radio. I wondered how I would possibly survive the next hour.

Then the music stopped. I heard the truth about God, and my life changed. The music, it seemed, hadn't mattered at all. It still doesn't, actually.

Since I was in my twenties at the time, I think I can say that the idea that our church is failing our youth because we aren't hip enough just isn't true. My point is not to promote a particular worship style but to end the argument that young people will leave a church simply because it doesn't play to their particular cultural tastes. It's actually quite demeaning. Are they really so shallow? We might as well say that if Jesus had only been accompanied by a slick beat, the rich young ruler would have had a totally different reaction to Him.

We all know that's not true. The bottom line is that all young people have the same choice we have to make. They



can follow the message of Christ—or they can reject it. Jesus told the young ruler to be different, and the young ruler went away sorrowful. That reaction didn't change how Jesus delivered His message. Jesus isn't the one who failed. Get used to it.

Sometimes no matter how we present the message, it will be rejected because Satan has convinced others that the cost is too high.

I'm all for winsome witnessing, but I'm also proof that hiding the hard sale of Christianity behind a veneer of slick music isn't going to help anything. What will convince young people (and old people) to follow Christ is our agape love, the Bible truth, and the absence of hypocrisy in our lives. If we want them to survive this sin-sick world, they need to see us live the message, not mask it.

FOR A DEAD CHURCH

AN AMAZING FACT:

Legend has it that in 1775, the English trading ship Octavius was discovered drifting among the icebergs in a remote area of the Arctic. The



captain was found at his desk, apparently frozen as he made one last entry in his logbook. The crew was likewise found, some in their hammocks and some in the cabin, all frozen to death.

The last date in the logbook showed that for 13 years, the Octavius had been moving among the ice pack, "a drifting sepulcher, manned by a frozen crew." This is not very different from many churches out there—where members are stuck in position on cold pews going nowhere! ave you ever visited a church that seemed a little cold, mechanical, and lifeless? Or have you wondered why we have many small churches that don't seem to be growing— or why many big churches seem to be shedding members? As I travel for speaking appointments, it's always refreshing to encounter a vibrant, growing congregation because, unfortunately, it seems to be the exception. Well, why are so many churches stagnating? Could it simply be that because iniquity abounds, the love of many has grown cold? (Matthew 24:12).

Perhaps you are part of one of these churches. You'll generally know a dead church when you see one—the only outreach program is the sign on the building, and the youngest member is on Social Security.

The Scriptures tell us that the apostolic church was energized by the Holy Spirit and driven to spread the good news at any cost. This is why in one generation the gospel had penetrated into every corner of the Roman Empire (Colossians 1:23).

The Deadliest Infection

One of the best ways for you to experience a revival in a cold, sleepy, or dead church is to share Jesus with others. In fact, that's

the primary function of the church. So many small growth-less churches are so busy looking inward, after their own needs, that they only pay lip service to the great commission. The problem is that when our focus is inward and our needs are met, what happens? We stagnate, get bored, and don't see church for what God meant it to be.

You know this is happening in a church member's life when you hear, "I don't get anything out of church." Many Americans are spectator oriented; we are used to being entertained. Yet TV watching is a passive activity. You just sit there and soak it up. We often come to church with the same mindset, but in reality, church should predominately be where we go to give. We give our praise, our songs, our offerings, our service, and our attention to God.

If we would just escape this rut of thinking a church service is supposed to be



The core reason people are bored with their churches is they have hearts void of the Holy Spirit and, therefore, seldom have an appetite for spiritual food. But if we were hungering after righteousness, we would be less concerned with

> perceived faults. "To a hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet" (Proverbs 27:7).

> Ellen White put it this way: "While the people are so destitute of God's Holy Spirit, they cannot appreciate the preaching of the Word; but when the Spirit's power touches their hearts, then the discourses given will not be without effect."

Unfortunately, some

pastors think the only solution for building church attendance is to break out the band and bring on dancing deacons. If your pastor seems to be floundering for solutions for church growth, perhaps he needs your help. Let him know you're on his side and that you want the church to be alive and growing.

Advanced CPR for the Dying Church

The best way to energize a dead or cold church is to invite a non-member to attend with you or to win a new convert who will have that "first love" coursing through their veins.



You might say, "But I'm embarrassed to invite anyone to our church! It's so cold and lifeless that a blast of Arctic air enshrouds you as soon as you enter the door!"

I believe that new converts or sincere people who visit your church hungering and thirsting after God will not so quickly notice the imperfections that seem obvious to you. Rather, they'll help you get a fresh perspective.

One of the features of the body of Christ is that it constantly needs fresh transfusions of new converts to be healthy. The church must always be involved in evangelism to remain warm and vibrant. We are often caught in that vicious cycle of thinking our church is not ready for evangelism or new people when, in reality, evangelism and new people are the cure.

Working to keep others warm and alive in their Christian experience will help keep you from freezing!

And before you excuse yourself from reaching out to wake up the saints by saying you don't have enough experience, remember that you have exactly the same qualifications the 12 disciples had when they started out. Jesus sent them out preaching even though they were not completely converted or perfectly trained. Sharing their faith was part of their conversion process.

If you think you are in a dying church, get involved. You can even gather warmth from the coldness of others. An igloo might be made of ice, but it keeps the inhabitants warm! Need some ideas? Here are four keys to get you going ...

Start a home Bible study group. Some people who don't go to church will often feel comfortable in a home Bible study. If you come to church each week glowing from a home study during the week, you will have some warmth and light to share.

Drown yourself in good Christian media and materials. Listen to elevating Christian CDs and DVDs and pass them around. This will help generate spiritual conversations and is like giving a bowl of hot spiritual soup to someone shivering and hungry.

Energize your Sabbath School. Make an uninteresting Sabbath class come alive by asking thoughtprovoking questions that stimulate biblical discussion. For example, "How can I know if I'm really converted?" Just remember to generate more light than heat with your questions and turn to God's Word for the answers.

Pray for revival. Go home and get a piece of chalk. Draw a circle three feet in diameter on the floor. Kneel in the middle of the circle. And then pray that God will start a revival in that circle. When God starts a revival in that circle, a revival will have begun in your church. When revival happens, you might face new problems. Instead of trying to survive in a cold, dead church, your church might grow so rapidly you'll be wondering how you will now survive in a big church!

Survival Tips for a Small Church

One of the big problems that small churches face is the over-involvement in one another's personal lives. Sometimes there is too much meddling in private business. There also seems to be a hesitancy to let newcomers integrate into church leadership, even if the "newcomer" has been a member there for 10 years.

Here are some ways to help your small church not only survive, but thrive ...

Respect the privacy of other members and guard the privacy of your own home. While there might be nothing to hide, every family needs privacy. Ellen White wrote, "How many lives are made bitter by the breaking down of the walls which enclose the privacies of every family, and which are calculated to preserve its purity and sanctity!" Remember to give people their space and gracefully let them know when you need yours. Refuse to be a link in the gossip chain. When someone comes to you with a "juicy" story about another member, you don't have to listen. Try turning it back by responding, "Let's pray for them and leave this in God's hands."

Bon't play favorites. While it might be a temptation to join the "in crowd," remember Jesus was the friend of outcasts. He treated both John and Judas with equal love and respect.

Avoid power struggles for church leadership. Positions in small churches are generally held by a small group. People who cling to power often do so from a point of insecurity rather than strength. A person with leadership gifts who is strong in the Lord will not feel threatened by others and will give them an opportunity to exercise their talents. On the other hand, a person who is truly gifted doesn't necessarily need the leadership title in order to exercise their gifts; they don't mind if someone else gets the credit.

Search for hidden gifts. In a small church, it's often the same few people who do most everything. This is sometimes due to somebody wanting to maintain control, but more often it is because the same people are always asked. These willing

A Longtime Dream

After 44 members completed the Amazing Facts Bible School program, they were no longer timid about sharing their faith!

M ary Narcisse, the education director for the Bethel French Church in Trenton, New Jersey, had a dream. She wanted the members in her church to have a deeper walk with Christ and to be more familiar with the teachings of the Bible. When she was asked to be the education

director for her church, she prayed to the Holy Spirit for guidance on what to do.

When Mary felt impressed to lead her members through a Bible study, her husband, Joubert, who receives the *Inside Report*, suggested, "Why don't you use the

Amazing Facts Bible Study Guides?" He had gone through the lessons himself and enjoyed them so much. "They are excellent," he enthusiastically explained. He also had heard Pastor Doug Batchelor preach on one of their local television stations.

Church-wide Adventure

Beginning in February 2013, Mary invited members, each Sabbath after the church fellowship dinner, to gather in the sanctuary for the study. She even called Amazing Facts for some guidance. After enrolling the class members, the ministry mailed all the



materials to her address so she could pass them out each week. Following a time of singing and prayer, Mary or Joubert would introduce the topic. Then the members, from ages 13 and up, would break up into small groups and go through a lesson. Sometimes members had

questions or would miss a study. They would call Mary, who would guide them through the lesson so they could stay on track with the rest of the group. About 25 percent of the members participated in the program. Five months later, 44 members had completed all



the lessons and received their completion certificates. The graduation service was a high moment and even included a guest speaker.

At the end of the graduation service, Rooldy Alexandre, pastor of the Bethel French Church, challenged all the Bible study students to go out into the streets and preach the gospel. He urged them to share their faith with others. Many of the members expressed how hesitant they felt about witnessing before going through the lessons. But after thoroughly studying the Amazing Facts Bible Study Guides, they felt more competent and bold to do evangelistic work in their neighborhoods.

The Fruit Blossoms

Using the Amazing Facts Bible Study Guides, in conjunction with a revival service in August, the church welcomed 24 new members into the church. They were baptized on September 27, 2013. Mary shares, "Once our members went through the lessons and gained more knowledge about these truths, they were no longer timid about sharing. They felt ready to introduce others to the lessons."

Since this time, members continue receiving materials from Amazing Facts, visiting the website, ordering more resources, and sharing their faith with others. Some are going door to door; others are witnessing at local malls or with friends in the workplace. One of the best decisions

my wife and I ever made was to attend the Amazing Facts Center of Evangelism (AFCOE) outreach training program.

Ever since we completed our training, it has been our top priority in life for God to use us to bring other people to heaven. And we have been so blessed by His leading.

Yet while doing Bible work in the years following, it was troubling for us to see guests from the community come to an evangelistic meeting and then just as quickly disappear when the meetings were over or, perhaps, after the Bible worker left. We observed that many more people would come and *stay* in church when most of the *church members* were also actively involved in the evangelism cycle.

In fact, there seemed to be a definite ratio: The more church members were involved, the more guests God would bring—because the church was ready for new souls. We saw that the involvement of church members was the real key to success. It was the church members who had the connections in the community, whether they were neighbors, co-workers, or people they saw every week at the grocery store or post



office. And it was the members who would still be there in the community, long after we left, that would support the new souls brought into the church.

That's why it quickly became a real passion of mine to make church training a vital part of my evangelism focus. So



beginning just a few years ago, I set out to simultaneously train two churches, fitting in as much of the AFCOE training as I could into nine classes taught over the course of several weeks. The training included learning how to give a Bible study and lead someone to Christ, going doorto-door, doing bridge events, transforming the church culture into an atmosphere of continuous evangelism, preaching soulwinning sermons, retaining new people, and how to turn around and teach the same Bible worker training class. In very little time, there were 32 Bible studies being conducted by church members alone, and within a few months there were several baptisms!

Preparing for a Harvest

Recently, I finished preaching an evangelistic series in Brownsville, California. In the months preceding, I taught my AFCOE-infused evangelism training course to prepare the church to receive new seekers into the church. Even though there had been previous attempts at outreach without any apparent success, the church members put their hands to the plow with renewed courage, determined not to give up on the process of outreach. We had several seasons of fasting and praying; the church members went door to door and held a big community health expo, which attracted more than 100 guests.

Although this was a small, rural community (population 1,500), the outcome was incredible. Because the church members



and the guests themselves were inviting their neighbors and friends, there were new people showing up all the way through until the last night. We had a consistent attendance of about 35 guests and, by the end, there were six decisions for baptism and four others considering church membership. Fifteen of the seminar guests now regularly attend church and are continuing Bible studies!

We have seen this concept of "multiplication" take off in other ways as well. In one of the first training classes I did, there was a young man named Alex from the islands of Vanuatu. At the end of the classes, Alex came to me and said, "Brother Gabe, if you came here for no other reason, it was for me." Alex returned to Vanuatu a few months later and began conducting evangelism training classes right away. He's trained two groups of lay church members and recently held a series of meetings in which 18 people committed their lives to Christ. Praise God!

A Very Real Impact

When Stormy was a young girl, a friend invited her to church. It was the first time she had ever opened a Bible. She enjoyed going to that church and continued attending for a year until her family moved away. From that time on, she felt like she was wandering aimlessly. She would try



church after church, searching for a good fellowship, but nothing seemed right.

In the last several years, Stormy's prayers became urgent for spiritual renewal. She felt that if God didn't bring someone into



her life that could teach her the Bible, Satan would gain a strong hold upon her. One day, she went to the local community service center where she met a wonderful Bible worker couple, Val and Cheryl. Val shared a short Bible study, and she was deeply impressed that she was hearing truth. They started Bible studies and, just a few weeks later, she was invited to my "Revelation Revealed" Bible prophecy seminar.

She eagerly accepted the offer even though she was afraid of the book Revelation. She decided she would go, and if it started getting scary she would just step outside. She never walked out once. Stormy started understanding the Bible like never before. "I was so hungry," she says, "it felt like I had been starving my whole life. I couldn't wait to go again. Every night I would count down the hours until it began." On November 16, Stormy was baptized. "I thank God every day that He answered my prayers and brought this truth and these people into my life."

Bible Answers

Can a person find favor with God by living biblically but not going to church?

First, it's important to note that there will be many people in heaven who were not affiliated with a church, either because they did not have that opportunity or another reason that prevents them from that privilege. But one of the most important principles of Christianity is that we are saved into the body of Christ, which is another name for the church. When you are baptized, you become part of Christ's body and enter into the church.

So I would ask in return: Why would a person say they love God and His truth, but not wish to fellowship in love with His people? That's one reason God wants us in church-because it has people with similar faith and likeminded beliefs. It actually helps to bolster our faith and makes us accountable.

It is also an excellent environment to increase our capacity to love one another. People learn their most important lessons of love in the context of their biological families. Church families follow the same dynamic, especially with new believers. If a person says, "I believe in God and the Bible and want to be saved and baptized, but I don't want to go to church," it sounds to me like a man saying to his bride, "I love you, I want to marry you, but I don't want to live with you." It's saying you want the benefits of marriage, but not the relationship that goes with it. Part of the Christian experience is having a relationship with the church, the fellowship of believers.

I lived as a hermit once—up in a cave and away from society. In that kind of solitude, you have a tendency to become eccentric. Isolating oneself from society and lacking social contact begin to affect your mind; your brain sort of atrophies. You become socially inept. In the same way, it's important for Christians to be social with fellow believers in corporate worship and gatherings to avoid becoming spiritually eccentric and inept.

It's part of God's gift, so I encourage each Christian to find a biblical church in which they can grow into mature members of God's family. "And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved" (Acts 2:47).

My name is John.

I am 16 years old. Though I was taught about my faith at a young age, I never actually studied the Bible. Yet I was pretty convinced about my beliefs and once said, "I will never change my religion!"

workers are being worn out. Naturally, in a small church, there is a smaller pool of talent to pick from, but if the leaders are willing to take a risk from time to time, they might discover undeveloped gifts and hidden talents in their midst that just need an opportunity to be cultivated.

Add some new enthusiasm. Sometimes a church is small because its witnessing program is stunted and needs a transfusion of new members. As I mentioned, the church must always be involved in evangelism to remain warm and vibrant. If it seems to you that church members are more interested in maintaining the status quo than praying for revival, you can step out and have a one-person evangelistic series by witnessing for Christ. Give Bible studies, hand out witnessing materials, or invite a physician to conduct a community health seminar on diabetes, hypertension, smoking recovery, or weight control. The opportunities are endless.

Survival Tips for a Big Church

The challenges and social dynamics in large churches are naturally different from small churches. While it's easy for members in a small church to recognize a guest in their midst, it's equally easy for a new visitor to get lost in the crowd at a big church.

Overall, the key to surviving in a big church is to have several small "churches" within the large congregation, while keeping your eyes open for those drifting at the edges. Anything you can do to make your worship experience seem more like a family



gathering—a testimony time, for instance helps people to connect with one another.

Take the initiative by reaching out to other people in the

church. Some people complain they have no friends, but the problem is they're not being friendly. "A man who has friends must himself be friendly" (Proverbs 18:24). Try greeting newcomers or sit by someone who seems to be alone in the crowd. It's amazing how often people in a large church sit in the same place every week and never meet the folks sitting in other sections. Be friendly and try sitting in a different place each week!

If you have needs—such as for counseling, Bible study, or even practical necessities make them known. Most large

churches have pastoral staff or lay-leaders who can help with counseling needs or have contacts who can. Many are just waiting to be able to do their job of ministering! The pastor is often the last person to know when someone is sick, has experienced a tragedy, or is discouraged, because other members never tell him. If you don't know how to locate someone to help you, a good way to start is by getting a copy of the church directory or the list of officers from the bulletin. **Don't let the size of the church overwhelm you.** You might not be able to know each member of the church individually, but perhaps you can start with your Sabbath School class. Try inviting a few class members to your home for lunch or sundown worship on a Sabbath evening.

Sit up in the front. If you feel like a lone minnow in a school of sardines, just swim up the aisle a little closer to shore where you are less likely to drown in a sea of distractions. I've noticed at my evangelistic meetings that the ones who sit up front are generally the ones who get baptized.

Participate whenever there is an opportunity. Try going to the midweek prayer meeting. The size of the crowd is usually not so overwhelming, and the atmosphere is much more like being part of a family. If the church is conducting an evangelistic series, ask how you can help. Nothing will revive your faith faster than watching and helping new people come to Jesus!

Break the habit of just being a pew warmer by getting involved. Find out who is in charge of the program you have an interest in and let them know you want to be involved. They would be overwhelmed with joy if you volunteered your services! If you don't find the program that interests you, start it. **Start a church within a church.** Find other members who share your desire for revival and burden for soul winning. Then meet together for singing, prayer, Bible study, and witnessing programs.

Did you know that how you breathe can profoundly affect your energy level, your thinking, your general health, and even your relationships with others? Too many of us are shallow breathers, sitting slumped at our desks or crunched into our sofas or easy chairs ... all while our bodies and brains are starving for increased oxygen!

Consider some of the benefits of better breathing:

- The heart receives more oxygen and works with greater efficiency, improving circulation throughout the body.
- Muscular tension is reduced.
- The digestive and immune systems are enhanced.
- Better circulation to the brain results in clearer thinking, improved concentration, and greater creativity.
- Powerful neurochemicals, such as endorphins, are released in the brain, leading to an improved mood (here's where relationships benefit).
- Stress and anxiety are lessened.
- The body's energy level and endurance is increased.

Sounds great, doesn't it? Research has shown that proper breathing can even have a positive impact—to some degree—on such conditions as asthma, COPD, and congestive heart failure. That's

"The LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being" (Genesis 2:7 NKJV).

pretty amazing and shows how powerful and healing correct breathing can be.

Here are some ways you can start breathing right today and reap the exhilarating benefits of improved respiration:

- Improve your posture. Especially when you're sitting, give your ribcage room to expand.
- 2 Learn to "belly breathe." (You might need to lie on your back at first to get the hang of it.) Do some controlled breathing exercises. For example, inhale deeply for four seconds, then exhale slowly for four seconds; practice for a few minutes at a time.
- 3 Spend more time outside. Unless you live in a polluted city or near a busy highway, the air outside is generally much cleaner than indoor air.
- 4 When you can't go out, ventilate your home. Open the windows when the weather is nice, but even when it isn't so nice, cracking a window will give you fresher, healthier air to breathe.
- 5 Keep some live plants in your home. Plants are great air purifiers.



Minimize pollutants, indoors and out. Don't allow people to smoke in your home. Change to non-toxic cleaning and personal care products. If you need to use a product that calls for ventilation, do it outside whenever possible. Consider using a HEPA air cleaner in your home. Replace filters often in your central air/heating unit. If possible, buy HEPA bags for your vacuum cleaner. Test your house for radon. If you use gas heat, install a carbon monoxide alarm.

But one of the best ways to increase your oxygen intake is through aerobic exercise. Be sure to exercise away from traffic and preferably with trees nearby (trees are great oxygen factories).

There are so many exercise choices too: swimming, rock climbing, tennis, skating, running, cycling, gardening—the list is endless. Walking,



the most popular aerobic exercise, is one of the best and is an excellent choice for most people. Remember, it can take time to conquer old habits and form new ones, so don't get discouraged. Just keep working to bump up your oxygen intake and you can breathe easier, knowing you're doing something great for your body temple!
