Questions and Answers

Q: Why are we building the W.O.R.D. Center?

A: Simply put—to more effectively reach the lost. For more than fifty years, Amazing Facts has experienced rapid growth. God is using you and this ministry to reach an ever-increasing number of people every year, but doing ministry more efficiently requires more space—and we are currently "maxed out." To continue reaching an exponentially growing number of souls, more staff and space are required. We need facilities and equipment that will allow us to expand outreach.

Q: Will Amazing Facts incur debt on this project?

A: Amazing Facts currently has no debt. If necessary, we will finance a portion of the project. However, it is our desire and belief that this project can be funded completely through the sale of existing assets, such as our current facilities, combined with the generous, sacrificial gifts of our co-workers in Christ, those who long to see this work finished and Jesus return. Our board members and their families stand fully behind this project and have already committed \$10.5 million to it. We will not compromise the day-to-day mission programs of reaching people for Christ during this expansion project.

The W.O.R.D. Rising Up!

It's exciting to see the W.O.R.D. Center literally rising up out of the land. Here is a brief update on the two buildings and landscaping:

The Office. All underground utilities for the office space are in, basement exterior walls and slab are complete, and the structural steel for the basement has been installed. Hollow core planks for the first floor have been installed (to reduce noise for the recording studio) and the first-floor slab has been poured. The basement interior walls are being framed—with plumbing, electrical, fire safety, and HVAC work started. In the next few weeks, the basement exterior walls will be backfilled and the rest of the first floor will be poured. The first- and second-floor exterior walls will be formed and poured in July/August and then placed the first week of September.


The Worship and Evangelism Training Center. Basement footings, the slab floor, and walls are complete. The first-floor footings, stem walls, and column bases are finished. Underground plumbing on the main floor is done, and underground electrical, data, and media cables are being installed. Wall panels have been formed and are ready for rebar installation. In the next few weeks, the sanctuary floor and walls will be poured. Exterior walls will be placed the first week of September.

Property Work. The sewer and water lines have been connected to public utilities. Work on paving along Sierra College Blvd across the front of the property has started. New lights have been installed at the intersection, and work has begun on connecting communication lines. During the next few weeks, paving and striping will be wrapped up on Sierra College and retaining walls adjacent to the two buildings will be built.
